**Faculty Positions, Department of Statistics**

**University of Missouri**

The Department of Statistics seeks one or more, non-tenure-track faculty positions on a one year appointment, to teach statistics during the 2009-2010 academic year, subject to budgetary approval. Applications are welcome for full – or part-time employment and are potentially renewable. Applicants for one-semester are welcome. Depending on qualifications, appointments maybe made at the rank of instructor or teaching assistant professor.

Applicants should possess at least a master’s degree in statistics or a related area; A PhD is preferred.

Fall classes begin on August 24 and candidates applying to start in the fall semester must be legally able to work in the United States on that date; if applying for the spring semester, candidates must be legally able to work in the United States on January 18, 2010. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until all positions have been filled.
